ITEMS WE ACCEPT:

Kitchen Items:

- Cabinets, countertops, sinks, dishes
- Appliances such as stoves, microwaves, refrigerators, and freezers

Bathroom Items:

- Bathtubs/showers, sinks, toilets, vanities

Household Items:

- Sofas, chairs, recliners, washing machines, dryers, desks, office supplies, antiques, glassware, books (novels, cookbooks, etc.)

Building Supplies:

- Doors, windows, lumber, shingles, tile, siding, insulation, drywall, electrical (fuses, breakers, fans—must have *all* parts), lighting, fans, flooring, tools hardware, plumbing, masonry, furnaces/heaters, hot water heaters, air conditioners

Lawn & Garden Supplies:

- Lawn mowers, shovels, tillers, trimmers, rakes, hoes, and tools.

ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- Broken/damaged or soiled goods
- Children's TVs
- Double ovens
- Cribs
- Cubicles
- Dishwashers
- Entertainment centers
- Faucets
- Large, out of date TVs, consoles
- Clothes, games
- Heavy large wooden desks
- Hospital beds
- Mattresses/sleeper sofas
- Old exercise equipment
- Pianos/Organs
- Reference books, dictionaries, encyclopedias.
- Sewing machines
- Unframed mirrors/glass
