- Ability to handle multiple projects simultaneously.
- Ability to work with a minimum of supervision self-motivated and confident.

- Ability to learn and use the Habitat for Humanity database system.

 equips prospective homeowners to better manage the responsibilities and obligations
 of homeownership.
- Implement post-homeownership program
- Regularly utilize broadcast emails, partner organizations, and other avenues to advertise homeownership program.

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- Create and distribute quarterly Habitat homeowner newsletter.
- Maintain communication with CDHFH current and future homeowners to engage in all CDHFH activities.
- Assist Family Selection committee as needed throughout the family selection process.
- Write biographies of partner families.
- Coordinate all ground breakings and house dedications.
- Handle all inquiries regarding CDHFH's homeownership and repair program.

A BRUSH WITH KINDNESS (ABWK): (Owner-occupied repair program)

- Develop and implement the entire ABWK program
- Develop outreach strategies to market ABWK program in Kent County and volunteer opportunities
- Coordinate with Construction Coordinator for site assessment
- Conduct screening process of applicants
- Develop internal administration systems to enhance service delivery

NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION INITIATIVE (NRI):

- Create and implement annual community outreach work plan with goals and specific strategies for increasing constituent support and tracking progress
- Identify and engage community leaders, stakeholders, and residents in targeted geographic communities where CDHFH is building/would like to build to enhance organizational visibility and to enhance new and existing opportunities
- Develop and utilize surveys to gage impact of Habitat in the community
- Implement and manage community evaluations using Success Measures Data System including training, planning, data collection, analysis, and reporting on data. Have clear understanding of the Success Measures NRI evaluation method
- Complete Economic Impact Study using Success Measure Data System
