Through this program low-income homeowners in Kent County are able to apply for assistance with exterior painting, landscaping, minor exterior repairs and other beautification projects. This program utilizes volunteer labor in an effort to impact the local community.

Homeowners are selected based on their need and willingness to partner.

Here are	the	basic	requ	irements	for	the	prog	ram:
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Own and reside in a home in need of minor beautification (no rental properties)
• The homeowner must be unable to afford and/or perform the work themselves
Have homeowner's insurance coverage
Reside within the Kent County service area of Central Delaware Habitat for
Humanity
Current eligible community is Town of Frederica
Income is 60% or below of the area median household income for Kent County
The homeowner must be honest and cooperative with CDHFH and agree to partner
with Habitat in all aspects of the project.
Homeowner and/or member of household must be willing to be present and assist
volunteers as able the day of the project.

The total household income must fall below the levels listed in this chart Minimum to Maximum Income

Copy of most recent tax return

- 1. Submit your completed application and ALL attachments to Central Delaware Habitat for Humanity. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- 2. CDHFH will review your application and complete a home visit to assess the potential project.
- 3. CDHFH will then review the application and site assessment for approval or denial. All applicants will be contacted regarding the status of your application.
