Things We'd Love to Take!

Please note that the list below is for donation items <u>dropped</u> off at the CDHFH ReStore location. Items eligible for pick up may slightly differ. All dropped off donation items must be approved by the store staff at our donation dock. Thank you!

Appliances

Must be in full working order and clean.

- Cooktops
- Stoves

Pickup Information

There is a **MINIMUM** of two large items per pickup. If the items are able to fit in a vehicle, please drop them off during Donation Center hours.

Cabinets

No cabinet parts. If painted, must be factory-quality paint/primed.

Must be complete with all doors and drawers attached. No nails or screws sticking out.

Flooring

All flooring MUST be boxed or bundled. Original packaging preferred. Tile MUST be unused. Carpeting and area rugs MUST be new. Hardwood and Laminate may be new or used with no glue or nails.

Furniture

- In good, resalable condition with no rips, stains or pet hair.
- No office furniture: Household desks 4' across or smaller and bookcases accepted.
- No baby furniture.
- No incomplete bed frames and waterbed frames not accepted.
- Patterned furniture accepted at discretion of Donation Ambassador.

Heating and Cooling

Air conditioners and heaters MUST be in good working order and less than 10 years old. Furnaces, Hot Water Heaters, Swamp Coolers and Fans not accepted.

Landscaping

Bricks, stone and cinderblock must be palletized for pick up and must be cleaned of mortar.

No used wood fencing accepted.

No fluorescent bulbs or fixtures and no track lighting accepted.

Lumber/Trim must be minimum of 6' long with no nails or paint.

Insulation must be new and bagged.

Roofing minimum of 1 bundle in packaging.

Sheet Goods

Minimum of 1/2 sheet (4'x4') without damage.

Must be complete, in good condition and full working order. Please verify with stores directly for any especially large tools.

No plastic containers. Glassware must not be broken or chipped.

Electronics

- No printers, copiers, or fax machines.
- No Big Box TV's. Flat Screen TV's accepted.

Windows and Doors

- No flat panel doors, shower doors, mirrored closet doors, or oversized doors. (Standard size is 80" tall.)
- If painted, must be factory-painted/factory-quality paint/primed.
- Patio/Sliding glass doors must be vinyl clad only.
- Blinds must be wood or faux wood and cordless.
- Windows must be vinyl, double-pane and under 6'x6' (36 sq. ft.) in size.
- Windows must be clean and intact (inserts in frame, etc.).
